**Grade Appeal Policy** 

EduGlobal College provides an opportunity for students to resolve grades appeals in a fair and

equitable manner. This policy applies to all EduGlobal College students who are currently

enrolled or were enrolled prior to submitting their concern in writing to the senior education

administrator.

Grades for course work are compiled at the end of each chapter or unit from the combination of

assessments taken. Assessments include projects/assignments, class tests, presentations,

participation in class activities, and evaluations of appropriate competences. Each corresponding

assessment will be assigned a score. The individual scores will be aggregated to arrive at a final

grade.

The minimum acceptable mark on any work is 50%. Only grades received on midterm or final

assessments may be appealed. Grades received for assignments or weekly quizzes may not be

appealed.

Grades may be appealed at the following times:

• When any course work or assessment is returned by the instructor, a student may appeal the

marks given by the instructor. If successful, the instructor will change the mark on the records to

calculate the final grade.

• When the exam results are given, students may appeal the grade with the instructor directly. If

successful, the grade will be changed in the student's file records. If it is unsuccessful, they can

send a written request to SEA. SEA then arranges a recheck exam of students from different

instructors. The SEA will make a decision based on rechecking the result of the same exam by

another instructor.

• Grades can be appealed twice on the same exam, if it remains the same, students cannot appeal

further. When the final grades are posted, students may appeal the grades with the instructor or

SEA. On review and if merited, the grades will be changed in the student records and notified to

students.
