

Important Update on Canada's International Student Program - What You Need to Know

Dear Partners,

We hope this message finds you well. At EduGlobal College, we understand the importance of staying informed about regulatory changes that impact our international student community. Recent announcements from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) and the British Columbia Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training have introduced significant changes to the international student program, specifically affecting institutions in British Columbia. We want to provide you with a comprehensive update to address any concerns and clarify what these changes mean for our partners and prospective students.

Overview of Changes

Canadian Federal and Provincial Governments have implemented adjustments to the international student program, aiming to streamline processes and enhance the quality of education for international students. Notably, within BC, these changes include a new policy that restricts the enrollment of international students to private schools, colleges and universities that are not already designated by Educational Quality Assurance for a two-year period. This is a move to ensure that students receive education from established and reputable institutions.

Impact on EduGlobal College

EduGlobal College, with its focus on academics and its commitment to the highest level of student services is well within the criteria set by the new regulations. In fact, we welcome any reasonable regulation that makes certain international students are receiving the best education possible. Our commitment to the highest standards ensures that our institution remains a preferred choice for international students. For those who have already applied for their visa, please be assured that there are no changes to your application process. Your visa will be processed according to the standard procedures.

Guidance for Prospective Students

For students who are planning to apply and had not submitted their visa application before January 22nd, 2024, we advise a temporary pause. The new regulations require the submission of an attestation letter with the visa application. EduGlobal College is in the process of obtaining detailed guidelines from the government regarding required attestation letters and will be ready to assist our students with the necessary documentation once the procedures are clarified.
